Thank you for your kind e-mail. The Finnish Environment Institute acknowledges receipt of the letter (2023-07-20 Nr. D8(E)-4399).

The Finnish Environment Institute provided its response and the received statements from the Finnish authorities and expert agencies concerning the EIA documentation on 7 June 2023 (ref: SYKE/2023/708). Finland shall not make any further comments at this stage and does not consider it necessary to continue the transboundary procedure. It is now a matter for Lithuania to consider how the comments will be taken into consideration in the further process of the project.
