SUMMARY INFORMATION ON FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROVIDED BY LITHUANIA TO DEVELOPING COUNTRIES IN 2011 – 2012

The information gathered consists of official information from the “Fast Start Finance” contributions, which was submitted to the Secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), for the year 2011 and 2012. No contributions through bilateral or regional channels were provided in 2012. All of the funding for 2011 and 2012 was new and additional, because Official Development Assistance (ODA) was specified to be climate related and other official flows (OOF) was provided through designated Climate Change Special Programme fund, all committed as assistance to developing countries under the UNFCCC after the pledges and commitments were announced at COP15 in Copenhagen. Lithuania did not provide any technology support to developing countries in 2011 and 2012. Please see the tables below with detailed information.
