REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE ON THE SIZEWELL C PROJECT IN ENGLAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania would like to thank the Planning Inspectorate for providing the information on the Environmental Assessment procedure for the Sizewell C Project, a new nuclear power station in Suffolk, on the East coast of England, United Kingdom.

Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania, acting as an authority responsible for coordination of transboundary EIA and SEA processes in accordance with the UNECE Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) has finished the procedures of informing the public and consulting relevant Lithuanian authorities. No responses were received during the public consultation, and national authorities provided no arguments or concerns regarding significant negative environmental impacts.

Consequently, Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania does not consider the Project to have likely significant adverse transboundary effects on the environment of Lithuania and therefore does not intend to participate in the environmental impact assessment procedure under paragraphs 5 to 8 of Article 3 and Articles 4 to 7 of the Espoo Convention.
